Fun Inter Iwi Event rules

Dolphin Dive - FUN EVENT- Each house has 1 ball. Each student must get the ball from half way down the pool to the shallow end, keeping their hands behind their backs. Boys half way down pool, girls down the shallow end. You may walk/run for this event. Students to start in the pool. Keep going until the whistle blows that time is up. The results are based on how many times the ball travels up and down the pool. Points – 1st-10 points, 2nd -8 points, 3rd – 6 points, 4th – 4 points.

Human Chain . You can use as many people from your house as possible. Rules for this event are: Boys will start from the deep end of the pool girls will start at the shallow end of the pool. One person in at a time-NO BOMBING. You must be the quickest house to form an unbroken chain for the full length of the pool with your hands joined in the air. Points – 1st-10 points, 2nd -8 points, 3rd – 6 points, 4th – 4 points. An additional 10 points will be awarded to the Iwi with the largest number of students in the chain.

Truck & Tractor – FUN EVENT- A senior/Intermediate student will tow a junior/sub junior student one length of the pool. Students must change with each length. This event is timed. Keep going until time is up. The Iwi with the most lengths completed wins the race. Points – 1st-10 points, 2nd - 8 points, 3rd – 6 points, 4th – 4 points.

- Make your way to the **EVACUATION ASSEMBLY POINT**
- A **FIRE WARDEN** will direct you to your assembly point
